Public Notice of
Five-Year Review
New Brighton/Arden Hills Superfund Site
Ramsey County, Minnesota

The U.S. Army, in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA), is conducting a five-year review of the New Brighton/Arden Hills Superfund Site. The Site includes the Twin Cities Army Ammunition Plant (TCAAP). The Site was placed on the National Priorities List in 1983, and includes soil and shallow groundwater contamination on-TCAAP, and deep groundwater contamination both on- and off-TCAAP. Remedies were selected through Records of Decision (RODs) in 1992, 1993, and 1997, and subsequent ROD modifications. For soil, the remedies include soil vapor extraction; excavation, stabilization, and off-site disposal; construction of soil covers; and land use controls. For groundwater, the remedies include pump-and-treat systems, monitored natural attenuation, and land use controls. It is expected that a draft copy of the Five-Year Review Report will be available for public comment in late April 2009.
